CSU faculty want to make it clear the lavish giveaways to CSU executives, massive fee hikes, efforts to privatize the CSU, and take-back bargaining proposals, such as the refusal to pay previously negotiated salary increases in 2008-09 and 2009-10, must stop now! By prioritizing executive pay and perks over the needs of students, faculty, and staff, Chancellor Reed has chosen a path that hurts the CSU and all of California. Students are paying more and getting less. Meanwhile, faculty are working more for less. A stable, supported faculty workforce means quality education for our students.
